This is in reference to the proposal to transform existing library hubs into a Library and Innovation Hub (LIH). This transformation is envisioned to support the schools in addressing the demand for 21st century learning where participatory learning happens to foster creativity of the learners. It shall serve as a support facility to the limited school library services and resources. The LIH is envisioned to serve as well as a digital media laboratory aside from being a warehouse of print, non-print SLRs, and equipment with high monetary values (which cannot be provided to individual schools) where learners and teachers can experience which includes features and services that shall include but not be limited to the following:

- 1. Mobile Library Services. Deliver to and collect learning resources from the school libraries;
- 2. Makerspace. A venue for hands-on, creative ways for learners to design, experiment, and invent as they engage with the variety of tools and technology where learners can create projects through programming, recording, editing, etc. that uses any combination of art and technology or both high tech and no tech tools:
- 3. Collaboratory. A provision of a library space that promotes collaboration, group discussions, and a training venue for teaching and learning with stateof-the-art smart technologies;
- 4. Venue for various learning resources processes. A place for market scoping for school library collection development and other learning resources processes;
- 5. Promotion of Media and Information Literacy. The 21st century learning needs for library staff that teach media and information literacy through complimentary, supportive, and team efforts; and
- 6. Access to digital learning resources, data conversion, and creation of digital contents. A facility to access hub-based subscribed digital learning

Based on the current physical structure of the existing library hubs, the regional office is hereby requested to recommend which of these hubs shall serve as proposed pilot Library and Innovation Hub. This facility shall basically have the circulation section with storage for the print SLRs and Science and Mathematics equipment, laboratories such as a makerspace, digital media lab which features recording, broadcasting, creative imaging, and a convertible collaboratory area for various learning resource processes to be conducted such as book fairs, a temporary storage space of the delivered SLRs for schools, and venue for seminars. The Bureau of Learning Resources (BLR) shall provide these materials and equipment to all the pilot Library and Innovation Hub.
